In doing so, it is the policy of Air Liquide UK and Energas to minimise the environmental impacts of our activities. Thus, we are committed to:

- Maintain BS EN ISO 14001 registration for all our operations:
- Take all essential measures to prevent pollution when handling substances associated with our production and distribution facilities;
- Control energy consumption and ensure continuous improvement on energy performance;
- Maintain the continuous improvement of our environmental performance and the prevention of pollution through the implementation and regular review of the Environmental Management System;
- Meet and, where possible, exceed the requirements of all applicable legislation and other standards to which we adhere in relation to environmental aspects;
- Set and regularly review environmental objectives and targets in line with the Air Liquide group commitments;
- Document, implement and maintain the Environmental Management System;
- Communicate the Environmental Management System to all people working for or on our behalf;
- Make this policy available to the public on-line and by personal request;
- Regularly review this policy to take into account any operational or organisational changes.

In seeking to secure continuous environmental performance improvement we will:

- Review our company raw material resources to ensure that, wherever possible, recycled materials are employed, the use of non-renewable resources is subject to continuous efficiency improvement;
- Aim to reduce the overall use of fossil fuels by conserving energy where this is possible;
- Implement waste management procedures to ensure that recyclable materials are recovered to the maximum extent feasible and spent substances are disposed appropriately;
- Encourage our suppliers and contractors to develop sustainable management practices;
- Conduct awareness campaigns and prepare training material to increase the understanding of our employees and customers with regards to the environment and sustainable development;
- Develop a Corporate Social Responsibility programme in accordance with Air Liquide Group quidelines.
